










This programme runs during the National Certificate in Educational Achievement (NCEA) external examinations and is provided for International Students **not** sitting NCEA examinations. The programme is covered by the Term 4 tuition fees international students have paid. A few optional activities have additional fees attached, such as Surf lessons and Horse Trekking. Activities and options may change if availability and weather conditions require. The programme is primarily an Outdoor Education Programme and is run by Orewa College staff. It is educational, in nature and requires students to challenge themselves and learn and grow. Some activities require them to "give back". It is different from a tourism programme.
